GETTING TO BMB FISHING RESORT

The preferred arrival method is for your group to fly into Hermosillo, Mexico. You will then sit back and enjoy refreshments and snacks on your 1 1/2 hour journey to your adventure at the BMB Resort

You can also fly into Tucson, Arizona and we can pick you up at the airport. This drive is approximately five to six hours.

Or, you can drive to Tucson, Arizona with your boat and follow us down to the Resort.

A passport is required to enter Mexico by air or auto after December 2007.



Suggested items to bring with you:

- Comfortable clothing suitable for a range of daytime temperatures from 70 to 90 degrees and nighttime temperatures from 45 to 65 degrees.
- Sunscreen, chapstick, snacks, sunglasses, bandanna to protect your neck, personal hygiene needs, any medicines, rain gear and a wind breaker jacket. If you wear glasses, bring leashes to hold them on your face.
- Your favorite reels. BMB will supply poles and have reels if you need them.
- Your tackle, lines and lures.
